

ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

12-16-13 through 1-5-14

Waste Water Treatment Plant

- Flows have averaged about 300,000 GPD since the last Council meeting.
- Maintenance continues.
- Solar Plant met with me the week of 12-27-13 and they changed the rates again. I plan to meet with Ohio Edison to see if this is going to benefit the Village at all. They are going to increase the rate by 4% starting at year 1.
- Issue 1 Round 27 contract was received this week and has been signed and returned to OPWC. It is still our plan to start this project after the first of the year
A resolution will be on the agenda in January allowing us to go out for bid.

Sanitary Sewer Collection System

- No problems to report this period.
- We will be cleaning as time and manpower permit over the next few weeks.

Water System and Water Plant

- We continue to perform normal maintenance at the plant.
- Other than the normal meter and curb box repairs all things in town has been normal.
- We are working with a contractor and the adjuster to get started on the repair at the water plant ceiling after the line broke right before the holidays. I will be contacting the adjuster after our meeting on the 6th of January

Other issues

The new agreement for police radios and dispatch service was returned to the Sheriff's office on 12-17-13. I requested a signed copy of the agreement. The total per month will be about \$1,000 for dispatch and \$70.62 per month for the radios through June 30, 2014 than it goes to \$12.50 each or \$137.50 per month through June 2015.

Recreation / Pool

- Pool has been winterized.

Street / Storm Sewer

- Cold patching of the streets is ongoing.
- We worked through the weather events during the holidays and used about 50 ton of road salt during the recent storm event.
- During the rain event all of the equipment was moved to the water plant and the safety salt was loaded in our dump trucks just in case water breached its banks.

Development

- Nothing new at this time.
