

ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

2-2-15 through 2-15-15

Waste Water Treatment Plant

- Sewer Plant running fine, nothing new to report.
- Continued with daily testing and other normal maintenance.

Sanitary Sewer Collection System

- Monthly service to the system is being done as time permits.
- Our Issue 1 application has been sent to small government for funding consideration. I need to provide age of system information and the number of residents that the improvement will benefit in the Village. This is due by March 13, 2015. I will have this completed and submitted OPWC by 2-20-15. We should score in the mid 60s and the cut off last year was 57.

Water System & Plant

- We continue to perform normal maintenance at the plant.
- We had a mainline leak near First Knox on W Marion Rd. The water had to be shut down because the line had a crack in the pipe and a tee that was leaking in the 60 line. A boil order was issued to effected businesses.
- On Sunday due to the rain the compacted gravel was thrown out of the hole by traffic. I was called on Sunday afternoon by the Mayor and PD and arrived within 20 minutes with the loader to fill the holes when I was confronted by drivers that hit the holes. Even though there were cones which should have alerted people to slow down they did not. I advised the drivers they would have to contact their insurance company.
- I monitored the holes and found that the traffic continued to erode the gravel from the holes, so I called in some help to place a plate over the hole which was creating the most problems. I placed the large cones in front of the second hole and someone ran over the cones and destroyed one of them and I again repositioned cones as a

warning. Repairs were made first thing Monday morning. They will have to be excavated once weather moderates to allow a permanent fix.

- Other than the normal meter and curb box repairs all things in town has been normal.

Other issues

Recreation / Pool

- Closed for the season.

Street / Storm Sewer

- Cold patching of the pot holes around town over the past two weeks continues. If you see any holes in the streets that we don't get filled, please notify me so they can be addressed.
- We did receive notice from the CSX engineer that they have the permit and have done the review. We might hear something the first of February but there are still some problems to be resolved.
- Salt is available but for \$167.00 per ton delivered. Could get it cheaper if we pick up but closest location is Cincinnati.
- We cleaned a number of storm drops in the downtown and around the community.

Development

- Goodwill Industries will be coming to town soon and will be located in the space previously occupied by the Movie Gallery.
- Also the Salvation Army will have an office at the office next to McClelland Chiropractic on W Marion Road.
