

ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

1-20-15 through 2-1-15

Waste Water Treatment Plant

- Sewer Plant running fine, nothing new to report.
- #2 Vaughn pump has had seal replaced.
- Continued with daily testing and other normal maintenance.

Sanitary Sewer Collection System

- Monthly service to the system is being done as time permits.

Water System & Plant

- We continue to perform normal maintenance at the plant.
- We had a mainline leak near Grant Street and Catalpa Ln. The water had to be shut down because the leak was a crack in the line near a tap. A boil order was issued to effected residents.
- Other than the normal meter and curb box repairs all things in town has been normal.
- The Clerk issued 69 shut off notices for the month of January and 7 were shut off.

Other issues

- During the ice storm I had an accident with the 2008 Crown Vic and damaged the right rear of the car. I hit the ice going down the hill at the street shop and hit the salt spreader on the 550 dump truck. The truck was not hurt but the right rear quarter panel was badly damaged. It is not worth fixing and we will sell this one on the sale vs the 07. One more reason to leave these cars parked if it gets slippery. They are just not stable in the snow and ice.

Recreation / Pool

- Closed for the season.

Street / Storm Sewer

- Cold patching of the pot holes around town over the past two weeks continues. This work is ongoing.
- We did receive notice from the CSX engineer that they have the permit and have done the review. We might hear something the first of February but there are still some problems to be resolved.
- We have been doing our best to keep the streets and sidewalks clear of snow and ice. The biggest problem for the PD and Street is getting people to move their cars so we can plow the streets. Capt. Underwood assisted us on Monday with getting cars moved. This help expedited the cleanup of the streets.
- I have made an effort to purchase salt from Cargill or Morton and cannot get any response. Will call Franklin County to see if there is any available.
- We cleaned a number of storm drops in the downtown and around the community. We had a major plugged line at HPM St. and W High St. This took a while to resolve. It was full of gravel, leaves and other debris.
