

ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

2-16-15 through 3-1-15

Waste Water Treatment Plant

- Sewer Plant running fine, nothing new to report.
- Continued with daily testing and other normal maintenance.

Sanitary Sewer Collection System

- Monthly service to the system is being done as time permits.
- We were called to the south alley behind W High St. between Town and Delaware St. This was the same problem as in the past. The line was partially filled with sludge. We cleaned over 350 feet until we hit a dead end. This is where we need to install a manhole. We hope to complete this task in the spring 2015.
- NO CHANGE -Our Issue 1 application has been sent to small government for funding consideration. I need to provide age of system information and the number of residents that the improvement will benefit in the Village. This is due by March 13, 2015. I will have this completed and submitted OPWC by 2-20-15. We should score in the mid 60s and the cut off last year was 57.

Water System & Plant

- We continue to perform normal maintenance at the plant.
- We had a mainline leak on Bank Street near Whetstone School. This was repaired on Monday 2-23-15 with no problems.
- Other than monthly testing everything else went well over the week.
- We monitored our elevated tanks during the cold snap, Tim had reported some of his clients had reported that their down pipes were freezing up. In our system there is almost always flow in our down pipes because the high district is feeding the low district through the 10" line that runs from the water plant, down Park Ave and over to the Douglas St tower.

- Other than the normal meter and curb box repairs as weather permits, all things in town has been normal.

Other issues

- I gave you all copies of the electric and gas agreements for the Village. This is an every three year deal where companies give us the lowest price over a three year period.
- I also included a copy of the T Mobile easement to direction bore a fiber optic line to their pedestal at the water tower. They wanted to do this and pay the Village nothing because they have a current agreement with us on their antennas on the tower. I said no because this is new and is being install by Time Warner. The paid us the going rate for fiber optic easements. Based on the distance we will receive the same rate per foot that the Agricultural Society received from ATT.
- We received a letter for the prosecutor saying that we could have access to HPM Plant 2 on SR 95 to do the Phase 1 & 2 assessments on the site. We will be talking with the USEPA and SME our Engineering Team on the project the first of March.

Recreation / Pool

- Closed for the season.

Street / Storm Sewer

- Cold patching of the pot holes around town over the past two weeks continues. If you see any holes in the streets that we don't get filled, please notify me so they can be addressed.
- We continue to work on the storm project for Round 28 and CSX.

Development

- Nothing new to report at this time.
