

ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

4-7-15 through 4-19-15

Waste Water Treatment Plant

- Sewer Plant running fine, nothing new to report.
- Continued with daily testing and other normal maintenance.
- Drained and replaced oil in the blower drives.
- Tested oil in drives on Oxidation Ditch.
- Looking into problems with our current dialer and replacing it with a state of the art dialer using cell phone technology. Also will be upgrading the software provided by the supplier on the Orchard Drive pump station.

Sanitary Sewer Collection System

- Monthly service to the system is being done as time permits.
- **NO CHANGE** -Our Issue 1 application has been sent to small government for funding consideration. I need to provide age of system information and the number of residents that the improvement will benefit in the Village. We should hear something on this by late June 2015.
- We finally received the refund from the Petroleum Underground Release Compensation Board, requested back in 2007 in the amount of \$5,950.00. It was put back into the sewer fund.

Water System & Plant

- We continue to perform normal maintenance at the plant.
- Parts were received for the Chlorine system and have been installed.
- Other than the normal meter and curb box repairs as weather permits.
- Hydrant flushing took place on Thursday 4-9-15 and 4-16-15 and the final will be on 4-23-15.

Other issues

- We are just about ready to start the work on the Phase 1 & 2 assessments at HPM Plant #2. Work should begin around the first of May 2015.

Recreation / Pool

- The pool water was turned on this week and the outside restrooms will be open for Baseball and Softball practice in the evenings.
- We have been cleaning up and rolling the lawns in the recreation areas. Everything was moved last Thursday and we will try to stay ahead of the growth over the next few weeks.

Street / Storm Sewer

- Cold patching of the pot holes around town over the past two weeks continues. If you see any holes in the streets that we don't get filled, please notify me so they can be addressed.
- We continue to work on the storm project for Round 28 and CSX. We sent the specifications on the pipe and the directional boring procedure. The Chief engineer said he would make a recommendation to allow the jack and bore of the 60" casing to carry storm water. We are waiting on the answer back from CSX.

Development

- The County Development office will be working on a possible third Sheriff's Sale for HPM. I have been advised that the changes to the next Sheriff's sale will soon be published but the Village has not been advised of the new language.
- I dropped off the CDBG application to the County Development office on Wednesday. This is the grant application for the Restroom and Shelter House for the Fort Gilead Recreational park. Nature Works is due the first of May 2015.
