

## **ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT**

**5-4-15 through 5-18-15**

### **Waste Water Treatment Plant**

- Two of the motors on the blower cabinets in the blower bldg. had to be replaced. The motors arrived on Wednesday and will be installed.
- The wireless internet from Omnicity went out after the storm and has been down since. Omnicity has been contacted. I have also contacted Century Link about DSL. It is available for \$80 per month because we have to pay the business rate.
- Continued with daily testing and other normal maintenance.

### **Sanitary Sewer Collection System**

- Monthly service to the system is being done as time permits.
- Our Issue 1 application has been funded by small government. We will receive an agreement the first of July. The project cost is \$344,315 and the grant is valued at \$254,793.
- Working on problem on Hickory Ln. the inspection manhole has arrived and we hope to install this next week. This will allow us to have access for cleaning the line and will eliminated the dead end line on Hickory St.

### **Water System & Plant**

- We continue to perform normal maintenance at the plant.
- Other than the normal meter and curb box repairs as weather permits.
- Yards have been being repaired as time and weather permits.
- A tree that died on Buckeye Ln will be replaced due to tree roots that were damaged during the repair of a water line on Buckeye Ln.

### **Other issues**

- We are just about ready to start the work on the Phase 1 &2 assessments at HPM Plant #2. Work should begin around the first of May 2015.

### **Recreation / Pool**

- The pool has been filled and filters installed. Chemicals will be started once the circulating pump is started up to shock the pool and get it ready for the 6<sup>th</sup> grade pool party. This is an annual event for the 6<sup>th</sup> grade.

- Trees have been planted around town. We were not able to replace all of the trees that were removed but at least 10 have been put back. The larger trees purchased have been placed where wires will not be a factor.

### **Street / Storm Sewer**

- Cold patching of the pot holes around town over the past two weeks continues. If you see any holes in the streets that we don't get filled, please notify me so they can be addressed.
- No Change / We continue to work on the storm project for Round 28 and CSX. We sent the specifications on the pipe and the directional boring procedure. The Chief engineer said he would make a recommendation to allow the jack and bore of the 60" casing to carry storm water. We are waiting on the answer back from CSX.

### **Development**

- HPM was sold last Friday to Middlefield Industrial Complex, Inc. the owner is Bill Marsteller. They plan to improve the property not tear it down. They have already talked to the company that purchased the cranes during the sale by Huntington. His plan short term is to get his landscaping company on site to mow, trim trees and just clean up the property. They will have on site security on site as soon as they close.
- **Pending** / I dropped off the CDBG application to the County Development office on Wednesday. This is the grant application for the Restroom for the Fort Gilead Recreational Park.
- **Pending** / The Nature Works and Land and Water Grants have been delivered to ODNR it will be late summer before we know the status. These are for the shelter House and Playground equipment.
