

ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

6-1-15 through 6-21-15

Waste Water Treatment Plant

- Two of the motors on the blower cabinets in the blower bldg. had to be replaced.
- The internet service for the sewer plant is now Century Link. The wireless service was not reliable and we needed to be able to transmit EPA forms monthly.
- Heavy rains over the period have been a problem and we have been in a storm mode for the last week or so.
- A new processor was installed in the septage receiving system. This was to replace the defective unit that was originally installed in 2007. As far as I know this is being handled as an upgrade under the service agreement.
- Continued with daily testing and other normal maintenance.

Sanitary Sewer Collection System

- Monthly service to the system is being done as time permits.
- Our Issue 1 application has been funded by small government. We have begun working on the engineering for the reline project.
- Many sewer problems with the heavy rainfall. We have been trying to deal with them as they come up.
- We also have been working a Hartman Printing to resolve the storm water issue due to runoff from the road. We have removed built up soil from along the Counties driveway to allow water to get to the catch basin. We have made improvements to the catch basin on County property in the rear of Hartman's property. We also cleaned up all of the grit from the gutter out in front of the property. We also filmed the main sewer line and the properties lateral on Friday 6-19-15 and found no issues. Mr. Hartman blames his sewer issues on the storm water running onto the property from the road.
- The clutch went out of the Vactor last week, I have a new one on order which will take two to three weeks. The jetter part is still working so we will be able to clean sewers if necessary.

Water System & Plant

- We continue to perform normal maintenance at the plant.

- Other than the normal meter and curb box repairs as weather permits.

Other issues

- Nothing new to report.

Recreation / Pool

- Nothing new to report.

Street / Storm Sewer

- Cold patching of the pot holes around town over the past two weeks continues. If you see any holes in the streets that we don't get filled, please notify me so they can be addressed.
- We now have the agreement from CSX. We hope to begin work within a couple of months.

Development

- Nothing new to report. Except the HPM site is being cleaned up and it looks better than it has for years.
- **Pending** / I dropped off the CDBG application to the County Development office on Wednesday. This is the grant application for the Restroom for the Fort Gilead Recreational Park.
- **Pending** / The Nature Works and Land and Water Grants have been delivered to ODNR it will be late summer before we know the status. These are for the shelter House and Playground equipment.
