

ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

9-2-14 through 9-14-14

Waste Water Treatment Plant

- Sewer Plant running fine, nothing new to report.
- Continued with daily testing and other normal maintenance.
- Cleaned covers on rotating disc on oxidation ditch
- Sludge tanks emptied starting September 3rd and finished on September 10, 2014. 500,200 gallons were hauled out.
- Solar array is now partly on line and operational. They have been testing and 100% of the array should be on line completely by September 26, 2014. Fencing will be completed within two weeks.

Sanitary Sewer Collection System

- Monthly service to the system is being done as time permits.
- Round 27 Orchard Drive, we plan to install the e-one pumps next week at Mrs. Wellers home and hopefully the Holland pump will be installed soon after. The electrical work has begun, the main disconnect and the secondary from the OE pole can be connected. The change from 3 phase pumps to single phase pumps has been approved by the engineer and is moving forward. The control panel is being reworked by UPI and should be returned within the week.
- The sewer tap was installed by Robertson Construction on Wednesday they should complete this work over the next week or so.

Water System and Water Plant

- We continue to perform normal maintenance at the plant.
- Other than the normal meter and curb box repairs all things in town has been normal.
- We installed the tap and pit meter for the First Knox Bank Thursday.

Other issues

- **PENDING** -Will be installing some water taps over the next few weeks on SR 42 and Fairway Lane.
- We will also be installing the water and sewer taps for First Knox with Robertson Construction over the next week to 10 days.

Recreation / Pool

- The pool is now closed for the season. Shutdown will begin over the next month or so.

Street / Storm Sewer

- Cold patching of the streets is ongoing, we placed about 2 TON of patch in pot holes around town over the past two weeks.

- WE were able to get the storm tile opened near the railroad crossing on W High and W Marion Streets. All of the tiles in these areas were completely plugged with the grit spread by ODOT during the winter months. This is an ongoing problem for our storm system as it is currently the system is in dire need of extensive repairs.
- ODOT will be making repairs to S Main St at the stop light and on N Main at the stop light. This work will begin on Monday 9-15-14 due to the delays by Robertson Construction on the water and sewer taps.
- I continue to work on Blight in the Village.
- Engineering work on Round 28 is complete, Poggemeyer sent the package to CSX along with our check for \$4,000 for the permit. The project will be advertised the week of 9-15 and 9-22 and bids will be opened on October 2, 2014.
- The yard waste has been ground and removed from the site. We were left a large pile for residents to use.

Development

- **Agreement is pending** - All of the paperwork has been filed with the USEPA on the Brownfield Assessment Grant. We are waiting to hear from them on the grant agreement. Should see this by October 2014.
- The United Way will be holding a Shack City to raise awareness about the homeless in our area on November 8, 2014, they expect 100 people to participate. This will be held on the southeast part of the square.
- Also the United Way will be hosting the Harlem Ambassadorø again along with a carnival which will be held on the Jr Hi practice field from 12 to 2 on 10-26-14 and the Ambassadorø show will be held in the High School gym at 3:00 PM on 10-26-14.
