

ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

9-5-15 through 9-20-15

Waste Water Treatment Plant

- Continued with daily testing and other normal maintenance.
- Started hauling sludge on 9-11-15 and completed hauling on 9-18-15. We hauled out about 500,000 gallons.

Sanitary Sewer Collection System

- Monthly service to the system is being done as time permits.
- We hope to bid the sewer reline project the first of September. After further inspection of Manholes that were to be rehabbed it was recommended that they be replaced. This change in scope was approved by OPWC. The engineer thinks the project cost should be about the same however if there is any cost above and beyond the project amount the Village will have to pay the difference.
- Our Vactor problems continued last week when we lost the output bearings and the fan. As with any piece of equipment that is over 16 years old you will have wear. We have worked through the complete system and tested and checked the tightness of mounting bolts. We should be ok for now but we need to be looking at a replacement. We are looking at another reconditioned unit from Doheney where we purchased our current Vactor. A new Vactor ó Jetter would run about \$350,000 and a reconditioned unit is around \$110,000. This is a piece of equipment that we can't do without in the Village.

Water System & Plant

- We continue to perform normal maintenance at the plant.
- Other than the normal meter and curb box repairs as weather permits.
- Repaired a water leak on Lee St. This was a damaged line by a contractor, pulled a service line out of a corporation valve.

Other issues

- The emergency repairs to the fire house roof will be done hopefully next week. A copy of the emergency repair order is in your packet.
- There will also be major repairs to the three 14ø doors in the fire house. All of the upper shafts and couplings will be replaced along with any hardware found to be defective. The rear door is to remain shut until the shafts are replaced and the door has been realigned. There is a danger that the door could collapse. Truck will be backed in until the door is repaired.

Recreation / Pool

- We are looking at the return line to the pump house as a possible source of our loose of water in the pool. The pool level has stopped going down just at the bottom of the gutter system

Street / Storm Sewer

- Cold patching of the pot holes around town over the past two weeks continues. If you see any holes in the streets that we don't get filled, please notify me so they can be addressed.
- I have prepared an estimate for Issue 1 Round 30 to repave the following streets; Cherry St, North St, Vine St, Meadow Dr. and Swimming Pool parking lot. Estimated cost would be around \$250,000. Our match would be 26%. This will overlay over 1.7 miles.
- We are scheduled to start the CSX project on 10-5-15. The project will take about 2 weeks to complete. The pipe will be installed the first week by Ours Excavating sub which is Riley Contracting.

Development

- Our CDBG application that I submitted to the County has been approved. This means that the restroom at the new playground will be built as soon as we receive the info from the County. Probably in the spring of 2016.
- **Pending** / The Nature Works and Land and Water Grants have been delivered to ODNR it will be late summer before we know the status. These are for the shelter House and Playground equipment. (expect to hear in October)
