

ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

8-18-14 through 9-1-14

Waste Water Treatment Plant

- Sewer Plant running fine, nothing new to report.
- Continued with daily testing and other normal maintenance.
- **No Change** - Sludge tanks will be emptied in September. A number of things have contributed to not getting the sludge hauled; arsenic level was too high and had to be retested twice. The high level was because we were sampling the from a pump port. This has been corrected and we are now sampling from a mixed tank.
- Solar array is now partly on line and operational. They have been testing and 100% of the array should be on line with in the week. More to follow.

Sanitary Sewer Collection System

- Monthly service to the system is being done as time permits.
- **No Change** - Round 27 Orchard Drive project is starting wrap up, have the e-one pumps now and plan to set them in the next week or so. They will need to be wired and the main pump station will need to be wired. Electrical is all that really need to be completed plus site work.

Water System and Water Plant

- We continue to perform normal maintenance at the plant.
- Other than the normal meter and curb box repairs all things in town has been normal.

Other issues

- Will be installing some water taps over the next few weeks on SR 42 and Fairway Lane.
- We will also be installing the water and sewer taps for First Knox with Robertson Construction over the next week to 10 days.

Recreation / Pool

- The pool is now closed for the season. Shutdown will begin over the next month or so.

Street / Storm Sewer

- Cold patching of the streets is ongoing, we placed about 2 TON of patch in pot holes around town.
- **No Change** - ODOT will be making repairs to S Main St at the stop light and on N Main at the stop light. Nothing additional is planned by ODOT at this time. I am waiting on a call from Dist. 6 on the overall plan for paving state highways within the Village.

- I continue to work on Blight in the Village.
- **No Change** - Engineering work on Round 28 is almost complete, Poggemeyer will be doing soil borings over the next week in order to send a package to CSX for review and to get the permit. We hope to bid sometime the first of September.

Development

- Still work to be done on CRA but still hope to complete soon. No change still need to complete.
- All of the paperwork has been filed with the USEPA on the Brownfield Assessment Grant. We are waiting to hear from them on the grant agreement. Should see this by October 2014.
