Clean up Days

NOTICE !! Trash must be set out on Monday for the (regular Tuesday trash route) and Wednesday for the (regular Wednesday trash route) . We will only make one round on each side of town. If it is not placed at the curb on the specified day it will not be picked up.

Please do not set out trash early – it will not be picked up until the specified days.

East side (regular Tues. trash route) of the Village: Monday April 21st and Tuesday April 22nd

West side (regular Wed. trash route) of the Village: Wednesday April 23rd and Thursday April 24th.

An independent company will pick up metal and appliances.
The recycle schedule will remain the same as the regular trash pickup days.

Yard Waste

Please note the Chipper schedule!! **May 19th and 20th, July 21st, and 22nd, September 22nd and 23rd.**

The chipper does not run on a regular weekly or monthly schedule. Only place brush at the curb on the first day that service is to be provided. We will only make one round on the dates brush is to be picked up.

Do not set brush along the curbs other than the scheduled dates. Grass and Leaves must be taken to the Yard Waste Facility, these items will not be picked up by the chipper.

Yard waste may be taken to the DKMM Yard Waste Facility (**next to sewer plant on Twp. Rd. 127**) Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 AM and 3:00 PM and on Saturday from 8:00 AM until 10:00 AM.

Hydrant Flushing

Hydrant flushing will begin the first Thursday in April. The schedule is as follows:

April 3 - north of High St. and west of Main St. to RR tracks

April 10- south of High St. and west of Main St. to RR tracks

April 17 - Section A: west of RR tracks to Edison Corp. limits

Section B: north of Union St. and east of Main St.

April 24- south of Union St. and east of Main St.

Holiday Hours

The Village offices and services departments will be closed on Monday, May 26th for Memorial Day and Friday, July 4th.

Life Line Screening

- Screens the carotid arteries in the neck for Stroke (75% of all strokes are linked to Carotid Artery Blockage) and the arteries in the legs for Peripheral Arterial Disease (PAD) which is linked to heart disease.
- Test for Aneurysms in the aortic vessel of the abdomen.
- Test for Osteoporosis - bone density screening.
- New! Screening for Atrial Fibrillation (Afib), irregular heartbeat.

This is a preventive program, and is really worth participating. These tests can reveal problems early so that the issues can be addressed and taken care of before they become life threatening. Results are mailed back to you and you are referred back to your own Doctor. These non-invasive, completely painless screenings take about 10 minutes and are offered for \$45.00 each (\$35.00 for the Osteoporosis screening) or have all 5 screenings for \$149.00.
